Chris is a wife and mother of 5 grown boys. An artist, who after a successful career in print media, put aside her art to care for her family. Now that her children are grown she has returned to art. She mentors young artists as well as mothers who seek her advice.

Chris credits the teachings of St. Josemaría as the key to her sanity in marriage and the busy mother of five. She will share the depth of his teachings sprinkled with personal anecdotes to bring these teachings to life.

The talk will be followed by a Q & A period and a breakout session on the role of women in society.

The presence of women in social life was a constant in the teaching of St. Josemaría. *“Women are called to bring to the family, to society and to the Church, characteristics which are their own and which they alone can give: their gentle warmth and untiring generosity, their love for detail, their quick-wittedness and intuition, their simple and deep piety, their constancy... A woman’s femininity is genuine only if she is aware of the beauty of this contribution for which there is no substitute—and if she incorporates it into her own life. ... Each woman in her own sphere of life, if she is faithful to her divine and human vocation can and, in fact, does achieve the fullness of her feminine personality.”* (Conversations, 87)

This workshop will unpack the seminal teachings of St. Josemaría on women so as to reach a deeper understanding of the nature of women and the dynamism of their role in shaping society.
